# Homepage

- 1 Browse drop-down menus from the blue navigation bar:
  - Theme
  - Country
  - Combination of Theme & Country
  - Catalogue -- type of content (i.e. books or papers)
- 2 Search\* by keyword, ISBN/ISSN/DOI, table of contents, title and country using the search bar at the top of the page.

\*Please note: This does not search full-text content (e.g. inside PDF).

# Advanced

- 3 Enter one or more search terms into the option fields and use AND/OR/NOT to link the fields appropriately.
- 4 If desired, narrow the search further using criteria such as:
  - Date
  - Language(s)
  - Content type(s)
  - Theme/Country
  - Sort Order (e.g. Newest First, Oldest First and Relevance)

There are more young people in the world today than ever before. Yet surprisingly little is known about the current state of affairs in youth development. Measuring the well-being of young people continues to be a challenge, even though its importance is widely recognised. The Global Youth Development Index and Report provides an evidence-based overview of the state of development for the world's young people, defined by the Commonwealth as those between the ages of 15 and 30. The Youth Development Index (YDI) is a composite index of 18 indicators that collectively measure progress on youth development. The YDI has five domains, measuring levels of education, health and well-being, employment and opportunity, political participation and civic participation among young people.
