The Global Youth Development Index and Report provides an evidence-based overview of the state of development for the world's young people, defined by the Commonwealth as those between the ages of 15 and 30. The Youth Development Index (YDI) is a composite index of 18 indicators that collectively measure progress on youth development. The YDI has five domains, measuring levels of education, health and wellbeing, employment and opportunity, political participation and civic participation among young people.
